4. PHC Service Cost Model & Humanitarian Accessibility

The PHC Service is delivered under a three-tier project portfolio model managed by each PHC Consultant:

1 Commercial Project

Charged at the full hourly rate (100%), providing professional sustainability for consultants.

2 Governance / Non-Production Projects

Addressing societal or regulatory needs at a partially reduced rate (typically 50–100%).

3 Humanitarian Projects

Including TTGD EcoSociety initiatives, delivered at just 10% of standard consulting rates, with consultants often contributing additional time voluntarily.

This model ensures:

- Humanitarian and community projects benefit from the same high-quality governance and risk control as large-scale industrial projects.
- Funding from commercial work cross-subsidizes humanitarian initiatives through a structured 10% levy, ensuring financial viability and transparency.
- Consultants maintain a balanced portfolio that sustains their livelihood while enabling social impact across Governance and Humanitarian projects.
