














My journey with dance movement therapy and art therapy showed me the transformative power of creative expression.

My vision is to create a society where every individual feels seen, valued, and empowered.





What if she had a reason to step out of her room, knowing that a community was waiting for her?



THE NEED: WHY THIS MATTERS







- 1 in 8 individuals is neurodivergent, yet very few receive tailored life-skills training to navigate adulthood.
- Young adults with autism, ADHD, dyslexia, and other neurodivergences struggle with employability and social inclusion.
- Parents of neurodivergent individuals often worry about their children's future, fearing a lack of opportunities and safe spaces.
- CSR initiatives focused on skilling, inclusion, and community development have the power to change lives.

- Skill-Based Paid Internships Participants work on live projects (designing, marketing, content creation)
- Micro-Business Setup Handcrafted products, digital art, or service-based projects run by members
- <u>Corporate Job Partnerships</u> Training programs aligned with hiring needs of inclusive employers
- On-Site Work Exposure Running café operations, assisting in workshops, or managing library & resources

YEAR 1 (2025-2026): Foundation & Pilot

Goal: Establish trust, proof of concept, and gather feedback

- Enrolment: 7–10 students
- Key Activities:
 - Launch enrichment classes (soft skills, arts, tech)
 - Conduct monthly community events (e.g. family days, talent shows)
 - Build trust with parents through regular feedback & counselling
 - Begin documentation of student progress and testimonials
- Staffing: 2 full-time, 1 head, 2 part-time/guest experts
- Infrastructure: Optimize rental space; add basic tools/props
- Outreach: Word-of-mouth, social media, and local WhatsApp groups
- Revenue Model: Fee-based model + CSR funding





YEAR 2 (2026-2027): Stability & Visibility

Goal: Strengthen systems, processes, and visibility

- Enrolment: 11-15 students
- Key Activities:
 - Launch a second batch or increase days per week
 - Offer a structured curriculum (life skills, expressive arts, tech skills)
 - Host 2 major public-facing events (e.g. art show, fashion show)
 - Form a parent advisory group to boost word-of-mouth
 - Refine assessment & progress tools for each participant
- Staffing: Hire 1 additional support staff
- Outreach: Partner with an NGO and schools; invite press to events
- Revenue Model: Add digital products or weekend pop-up workshops





YEAR 3 (2027-2028): Expansion & Innovation

Goal: Broaden offerings and intake while maintaining quality

- Enrolment: 16-25 students
- Key Activities:
 - Start weekend enrichment or sibling-inclusive events
 - Launch short-term themed modules (e.g. digital literacy month)
 - Pilot hybrid/online module for outstation neurodivergent youth
 - Collaborate with 2–3 CSR projects or corporate volunteers
 - Begin intern/volunteer program with psychology/education students
- Staffing: I program manager + visiting faculty pool
- Infrastructure: Add resources (laptops, kitchen space for life skills)
- Visibility: Apply for awards, publish success stories





YEAR 4 (2028-2029): Community & Consolidation

Goal: Deepen impact and prepare for scaling

- Enrolment: 25+ students
- Key Activities:
 - Run full-fledged annual calendar (academic + enrichment)
 - Launch parent support group and alumni mentoring circle
 - Begin partnerships with employers for pre-vocational exposure
 - Offer 1–2 paid teacher/therapist workshops under "Beyond Training"
 - Initiate a quarterly newsletter or podcast by and for neurodivergent youth
- Staffing: 1 inclusion coach, 1 admin/support staff
- Revenue model: CSR + paid programs + merchandise (e.g. student art/products)
- Impact Measure: Year-end student showcases, self-reports, parent surveys





YEAR 5 (2029-2030): Scale & Legacy

Goal: Establish Beyond Differences as a model centre

- Enrolment: 100+ students
- Key Activities:
 - Open waitlist or begin planning a second location
 - Share a replicable curriculum/toolkit for others
 - Conduct large-scale awareness campaign (e.g. Inclusion Week)
 - Launch an annual talent/leadership program for neurodivergent youth
 - Publish impact report and seek endorsements/testimonials
- Staffing: Dedicated marketing + funding strategist
- Revenue Model: Diversified income + brand partnerships
