#### 1. Project Snapshot

The TTGD (Through The Golden Door) EcoSociety in Mussomeli serves as the humanitarian foundation for TTGD's work in Italy. It focuses on building a self-sustaining local ecosystem for education, wellbeing, and transparent community aid using the Project Health Control (PHC) Service. Through structured monitoring and governance, the project ensures fair distribution of resources, empowerment of youth and families, and creation of local employment opportunities. Its long-term goal is to make Mussomeli a replicable model of ethical community management and equitable development.

### 2. Current Risks / Concerns

- Dependence on initial donor or grant funding for pilot activities.
- Need for capacity-building among early local coordinators.
- Coordination between municipal and community levels.
- Sustaining engagement and transparent reporting of community outcomes.

#### 3. PHC Service Offer

The PHC Service provides governance, monitoring, and structured delivery support across all EcoSociety projects. Each initiative undergoes PHC 7-Day Reviews ensuring risk control, transparency, and measurable community impact. The Mussomeli EcoSociety operates under the TTGD–PHC humanitarian rate (10% of standard consultancy fees), making it fully accessible for local development initiatives while maintaining professional governance oversight.

## 4. Commercial + Humanitarian Flow

Commercial and governance projects within Mussomeli will contribute a share of their PHC Service fees to the EcoSociety's humanitarian pool. This ensures that every project under PHC governance contributes to social programmes such as youth skills training, women's enterprise, community wellbeing, and environmental initiatives.

#### 5. Next Steps

- Finalise EcoSociety local leadership appointments and volunteer database.
- Initiate PHC onboarding and 7-Day Review for community readiness.
- Connect with Golden Truths University for training of first PHC coordinators.
- Establish initial funding mechanisms via PHC Service share flow.
