1. Project Snapshot

The Mussomeli Dairy & Livestock Estate aims to establish a fully integrated, sustainable dairy production facility supporting both local consumption and export opportunities. The estate will combine modern dairy farming, livestock breeding, and processing units within a single PHC-governed system. By applying sustainable feeding systems, animal welfare monitoring, and efficient resource use, the project seeks to enhance Sicily's food security while creating new employment opportunities. Under PHC Service governance, all activities will be monitored to ensure transparency, efficiency, and compliance with EU agricultural standards.

2. Current Risks / Concerns

- High initial investment required for land, livestock, and infrastructure.
- Limited access to financing for medium-scale agricultural enterprises.
- Environmental considerations and waste-management compliance.
- Need for trained local personnel in modern dairy-farm operations.
